Due to the adaptations produced by COVID-19, both last year and the current course (class XIX & XX) and in the following class (XXI), the start of the course has been moved to January. Classes are suspended for vacations from the beginning of July to the beginning of September.

Also a result of the adaptations to the COVID-19 measures, the master's degree is taught synchronously in person and virtually (up to a certain quota). The experience of both the XVIII and XIX classes has been very successful. However, the recommendation is to take it in person or for the most part.

The greater management and acceptance of virtual interaction has allowed us to invite a greater number of evaluation theorists that we would not otherwise have been able to assume. This year, for example, Robert Stake, Merel Visse and Evert Vedung have given extra lectures. In the XX promotion we plan to increase this type of teaching and lectures.

The deepening of certain topics such as impact assessment is allowing us to offer, in addition to the impact assessment sessions of the master's degree, a specialization seminar.

The agreement with Aproeval and with some NGOs is allowing us to constantly offer four scholarships of around 50% of the registration fee to complete the master's degree and a scholarship with paid internships. However, every year we try to expand this offer.

Doing internships is not mandatory, however, we have consolidated several agreements with entities from various sectors that offer us spaces to carry out design or carry out evaluations.
